FULL TIME FIREFIGHTER POSITIONS

Quartzsite Fire District is proud to announce that the District will be adding six (6) Paramedic/Firefighter or EMT Firefighter positions. This is being accomplished through the SAFER Grant program.

Quartzsite Fire District serves the Town of Quartzsite and surrounding communities. We are a proactive and positive District and are seeking service oriented persons to join our team. The District operates from one station to over 1400 calls a year and provides ACLS medical response, firefighting, vehicle accident response, HAZMAT, technical rescue, inspection and fire prevention to the local and unprotected areas. We are actively pursuing District expansion to add a second station within the next year.

COMPENSATION

EMT/Firefighter base \$37,252 plus AZSPRS (retirement), holiday pay, vacation, \$150 monthly EMT pay & health insurance. CEP/Firefighter base \$37,252 plus AZSPRS (retirement), holiday pay, vacation, \$600 monthly CEP pay & health insurance.

QUALIFICATIONS

Highly motivated, team orientated, selfless attitude, Firefighter I and II, Arizona Paramedic or EMT. Must pass required background check and have a clean 48 month driving record.

APPLICATION

For current employed District members submit a resume, letter of interest and a one page essay explaining why you want to be a full-time member of the District.

Non-members must pick up and submit an employment application, resume, letter of interest, one page essay explaining why you want to be a full-time member of the District current medical certifications with applicable cards (CPR, ACLS, PALS, Trauma), Firefighter certifications, and a 48 month driving record.

All applications are due by 17:00 on October 31, 2018.

TESTING

Testing day will be TBA but will be in November. All qualifying applicants will be notified of testing prior to November 9th. Testing will consist of a physical agility test, written exam and oral board. At time of invitation to test information will be given on physical agility test. All testing will be judged on a point base system with extra points being awarded for Paramedic, Military duty, College Degree and residency in the District. Applicants completing this process will be invited back for a Chief's interview.
